

# RECYCLING GUIDE

If not listed, it does not go in your recycling bin. Please keep it CLEAN!

**NO FOOD, NO LIQUID!**

## CARDBOARD

- Flatten all cardboard boxes
- Excess flattened cardboard can be placed beside or under your cart

## PAPER

- Office & Computer Paper
- Junk Mail, Envelopes, & Newspaper (remove plastic sleeves)
- Paper Bags
- Magazines, Catalogs, & Telephone Books
- Chipboard (cereal, food & cake boxes, etc - flatten these to maximize your space)
- Paperback and Hard Cover Books
- Carrier Stock (soda, beer can carry cases)



## METAL

- Aluminum - Cans, Trays, & Foil (trays & foil must be clean)
- Steel - Cans and Tin



## PLASTICS #'S 1-2, 5

- PET Bottles & Jars
- HDPE Containers & Jugs
- PP Containers
- Empty all bottles and replace the caps.



## GLASS

- Only applicable for customers who have signed up for glass. We will NOT pickup glass if you have not added the service.
- Clear, green, and brown glass bottles and containers only
- No broken glass
- Remove all small lids, caps, corks and toss these in the trash
- Larger lids (think pickle jar) can be placed with your mixed recycling



**The test of any good recycling is you should have no issues sifting through it with your bare hands. If the thought of doing so grosses you out, then you aren't recycling right!**
